


Percentage of Green in comparison to total budget allocation by state



Percentage of Green in comparison to budget estimated on identified schemes




■ Total state budget outlay

Department-wise contribution in Green Budget


■ Green Budget of Identified Scheme 2020-21

The Green Budget contribution since 2020-21 to 2022-23 has increased by 92% for Sugarcane department, followed by 78% for Building Construction department and by 63% for Animal and Fisheries Resources department

316 schemes/ programmes have been identified for green budget in the current FY, which was 267 in the previous FY 2021-22 and 103 in FY 2020-21
